Guidelines

All windows in the Village WITH OWNER PERMISSION are eligible. Washable tempera paint ONLY. Contest participants must clean their windows by November 3.

Age Groups: Under 5, Under 8, Under 11, Under 13- mixed age groups compete with the age group of the eldest child.

Entry: Upload a photo of your window and team information to "Pacific Palisades Woman's Club on Facebook or email to info@theppwc.org and we will upload for you. Include first and last names, ages and location of window.

Judging: Submitted photos will be judged and ribbons placed on winning windows. All participants are welcome to join us for the announcement at the Palisades Library on October 31.

The fine print

1. Print or pick up a Halloween Window application. Applications are available at the Chamber of Commerce, 15330 Antioch St. or online at www.theppwc.org

2. Complete the application and tape to the window. Groups may be up to five members. Groups compete with the age group of the oldest member. Under 5, Under 8, Under 11 or Under 13.

3. Reserve a window. Ask any merchant in the Palisades village on Antioch, Via de la Paz, Sunset Blvd, Swarthmore Ave or Monument St. Tape your application to the window to reserve it. One entry per window please. You may use an empty shop window if you can get permission from the owner.

4. Paint the window. Painting begins Saturday, October 11th and must be completed by Wednesday, October 29th The theme for this year is. **Mummies, Masks and the Moon**. Only washable poster paints (tempera) may be used on the windows. Please no props, glitter, googly eyes, glue or other items. Please do not cover large areas of the window with solid paint. Use BLACK, BROWN OR DARK BLUE PAINT sparingly for outlines and details only! It causes the windows to crack. Several thin layers of paint will adhere better than one thick layer. Mix the paints with dish soap for easier clean up. Paint in the shade if possible. You may wish to plan your window on a large sheet of paper before beginning to work. Plastic dropcloths must be taped at the bottom of the window and sidewalk during the painting process.

Tape your application clearly in the corner of your window, photograph and post to the Pacific Palisades Woman's Club Facebook page

Adult supervision is required. Please remember to select subjects in good taste. ADULT PARTICIPATION IS NOT PERMITTED AND WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.

5. Clean the window by November 3rd. Again, dropcloths are required under the window and on the sidewalk. Bucket and sponge first, then squeegee or window cleaner and paper towels works best. Clean in the shade if possible. Cold water on a hot window (or vice versa) will crack the glass.

JUDGING

PPWC members will judge the windows based upon four criteria: Originality, Artistic Ability, Neatness and Theme. Photos must be uploaded no later than October 29th.

Winners will be announced on October 31 at 4:00 pm in the community room of the Palisades Public Library. All the participants will receive a participation ribbon.
